

Regulations for Institution of Medals at UHS Convocation, 2022"

1. These Regulations shall be called Regulations for Institution of Medals at UHS Convocation, 2022.
2. The University shall institute Gold Medals for outstanding candidates, as approved by the Academic Council from time to time.
3. The cost of the Gold Medals instituted by the University shall be borne by the University.
4. University Gold Medals shall be awarded each year during the convocation, for outstanding candidates securing highest aggregate marks and fulfilling all the stipulations of the regulation, in the following courses/faculties:-
 - (a) MBBS
 - (b) BDS
 - (c) DPT
 - (d) Pharm D
 - (e) B.Sc. (Hons.) Allied Health Sciences (All disciplines inclusive)
 - (f) B.Sc. Nursing
 - (g) M.Sc. (All disciplines inclusive)
 - (h) M.S. (All disciplines inclusive)
 - (i) M.D. (All disciplines inclusive)
 - (j) MDS (All disciplines inclusive)
 - (k) M.Phil. Basic Medical Sciences (All inclusive)
 - (l) M.Phil. Basic Dental Sciences (All inclusive)
 - (m) M.Phil. Allied Health Sciences (All inclusive)
 - (n) MPH (2 Years)
 - (o) MHPE
 - (p) MSPH
5. The candidate should have passed the examination in the First attempt, in consecutive years, in all the years/parts/phase of the courses, with no gaps of studies, for any reason, whatsoever. The candidate should therefore have completed the course in the minimum prescribed time frame.

6. Further, the candidate should have obtained highest aggregate marks amongst all the eligible candidates, in the course / faculty concerned, at the university examinations combined held in that particular session.
7. In case of a tie, the medal shall be awarded to each of the candidates securing equal number of aggregate marks.
8. An awardee of medallion shall receive a cash prize of Rs. 100,000/-. In case a student is awarded more than 1 medal, the amount of cash prize payable shall not exceed Rs. 100,000/-
9. In M.Phil, the candidate must have submitted his / her thesis written in three (03) years from the date of enrolment.
10. No disciplinary action has been taken against the candidate during his / her entire stay at his / her institution / University.
11. In Allied Health Sciences, only those candidates enrolled in B.Sc. (Hons.) Revised Scheme, and in Nursing, those enrolled in B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing 4-years programme will be considered for award of medals.
12. Candidates enrolled in a programme being offered on-campus as well as off-campus will be considered for award of medal in that particular programme.
13. The list of awardees for the gold medals shall be prepared by the Controller of Examinations well in time to ensure presentation of the awards in the convocation. These lists will be placed on the University website and at least 15 days will be given for appeals in this regard.
14. Medals may be constituted in the name of eminent academicians and researchers especially in Health Sciences with the concurrence of Academic Council. The proponent of such medals, however, will have to deposit a sum of Rs. 1M under a separate head specified for the purpose in a specified bank account.
15. University shall not award medals in disciplines in which medals have been instituted and approved by donors.
16. Consequent upon the promulgation of these regulations previous regulations, notified on 06-04-2016 shall stand repealed.
