Information Technology/Software Engineering / Web Development

The University of Health Sciences (UHS), Lahore, offers paid internships to fresh graduates in the disciplines of Information Technology, Software Engineering and Web Development from the HEC recognized universities in Punjab.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The university is looking to bring in a technically minded, inquisitive IT/Software Engineering/Web Development Intern who will directly contribute to our web-based systems. For this, the interns must:

- Have completed BS/MS in Computer Science, Information Technology.
- Have a domicile of Punjab and age should not be more than 35 years on the last date of submission of the application.
- Have knowledge of the IT standards, including Software/Network and software development cycle.
- Have familiarity with at least one programming language & relational databases.
- Have knowledge of .Net Technology Languages/Frameworks/Systems (e.g., C#, Web Forms, MVC, Core, etc.) OR knowledge of Core PHP, and MVC frameworks like Laravel.
- Have the ability to learn new languages and techniques.

CONDITIONS

- The internship will be for a maximum period of 6 months as per University policy.
- The selected interns shall be placed at UHS City or Jinnah Campus, where they will be working full-time with the University IT Team.
- The interns will receive a stipend/allowance/wages per month as per the prevailing rates of the Government of Punjab.

The potential candidates can apply online at www.uhs.edu.pk/interns. The candidates shall also upload their picture, CNIC, Domicile and education documents.

The last date to apply is **29th August, 2024**. Only shortlisted candidates shall be called for an interview. Selection will be based on merit/equal opportunity.
