NOTIFICATION

In continuation of earlier notifications and for the information of all concerned, a meeting of Principals of all affiliated and constituent medical colleges was convened under the Chairmanship of the Vice Chancellor, University of Health Sciences (UHS), Lahore on 19th February, 2026 for deliberation and clarification on queries and requests regarding the Structured Clinical Training for the current Final Year MBBS (Annual Scheme).

It has been decided to implement the guidelines of Pakistan Medical & Dental Council to improve the clinical training by introduction of a structured and standardized logbook / resource book in various specialties. Accordingly, following clinical rotation schedule for Final Year MBBS (2025-2026) shall be followed:

All constituent and affiliated medical colleges are hereby directed to implement the above-prescribed clinical rotation weeks and ensure strict compliance with the defined competency-based outcomes.

Final year MBBS students shall undertake mandatory evening clinical training to enhance ward-based learning. In addition to regular clinical sessions during their college hours (8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. or as per institutional schedule), students will attend and record their supervised and structured ward rotations from *5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., under an assigned supervisor (night round), three days per week, which shall be included in their clinical assessment during final professional examination. This directive shall be implemented with immediate effect to strengthen practical clinical competencies and patient care experience.
