Agenda:

1. Consideration of grievances submitted by M/s Ideal Business Products and Mansha Brothers regarding the specification for the tender titled "Procurement of IT/Audio Visual Equipment for Shams Auditorium, City Campus, University of Health Sciences, Lahore" Tender No: UHS/PUR/R&M/26/329 against LOT-3.

Discussion

1. After detailed deliberation on the grievances raised by M/s Ideal Business Products and M/s Mansha Brothers on E-PADs portal, and after considering the technical briefing provided by the Director IT (Hardware), the Committee unanimously resolved as follows:
2. The Director IT (Hardware) informed the Committee that the specifications mentioned in LOT-3 are based on the functional requirements of the end-user and are commonly available across multiple projector brands in the market. He further clarified that the specified brightness of 6,000 ANSI Lumens is the primary technical requirement, while the specified resolution (WUXGA 1920 × 1200) and aspect ratio (16:10) are standard industry specifications available from various manufacturers and are not intended to favor or restrict any particular brand.
3. The Committee reviewed the bidding documents, BOQ, and the objections raised by M/s Ideal Business Products regarding the projector specifications. After review, the Committee observed that equivalent products from different manufacturers are available in the market

meeting the prescribed specifications. Therefore, the Committee concluded that the specifications are generic in nature, based on operational requirements, and do not violate any provision of the Punjab Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) Rules, 2014 (as amended).

4. Regarding the grievance submitted by M/s Mansha Brothers concerning tender documents on EPADS, the Committee verified that the revised CDR for LOT-3 had already been uploaded on the PPRA Punjab and E-PADS portal and UHS Website. It was therefore decided that the revised bidding document and the corresponding revised bid security requirement for LOT-3 shall prevail and be considered applicable for the procurement process.
5. The Committee recommended that the procurement process may proceed in accordance with the revised bidding documents already uploaded on E-PADS portal, PPRA and UHS Websites.

Conclusion

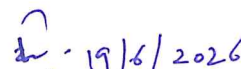
In view of the above, the grievances submitted by M/s Ideal Business Products and M/s Mansha Brothers were examined in detail and disposed of accordingly. The Committee found no evidence of any deliberate brand-specific restriction in the technical specifications and resolved that the procurement process may continue on the basis of the revised bidding documents uploaded by the Procuring Agency, with the revised bid security for LOT-3 being treated as valid and applicable.

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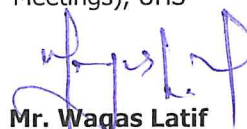
